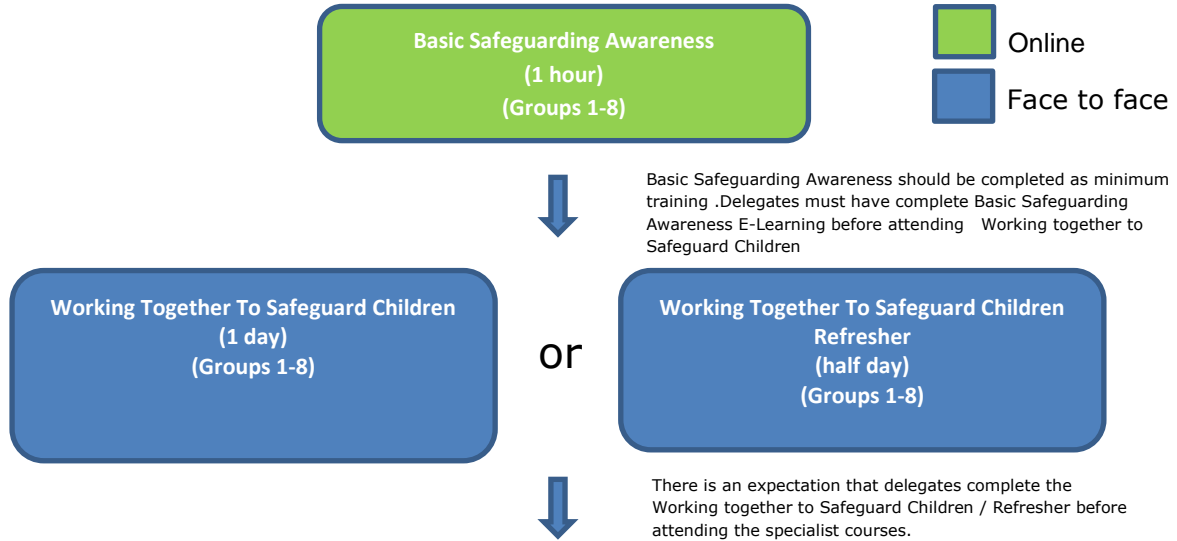

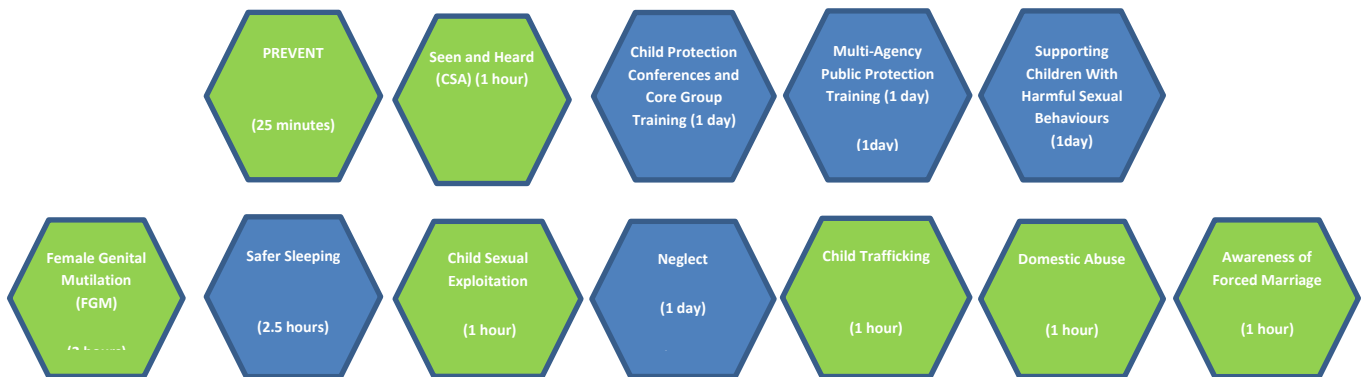
Which LSCP Training is Right for You?

Safeguarding children and protecting them from harm is everyone's responsibility. Everyone who comes into contact with children and families has a part to play. As a practitioner, ensuring your safeguarding knowledge and understanding is up to date is a key part of your role in keeping children and young people safe. Engaging in regular training is an important way to keep updated with new legislation, local practice and network with different agencies.
